

Spay/Neuter/Now Lewis County Fund

If you have not noticed, Northern New York is overrun with un-neutered owned cats & dogs and feral & stray cats.

Spay/Neuter/Now, Ltd. in cooperation with volunteers from Lewis County, New York has started a Lewis County Fund. This is a pilot program and is starting by raising funds to cover the \$50 per cat fee at the SNN Mobile Clinic for 17 stray/feral cats in Lewis County (\$850 for 17 cats). All Spay/Neuter/Now clients must go through an application process with income guidelines.

Additional funds will be turned into a discount program for Lewis County clients with cats coming to the SNN Mobile Clinic. The amount of discount will begin at \$10 off the \$50 per cat fee and will continue as long as the fund has resources.

This means that Lewis County clients will only need \$40 per cat at the SNN Mobile Clinic. The flat fee includes the spay/neuter surgery, rabies and distemper vaccinations, Advantage® for fleas and a check/treatment for ear mites. The flat fee does not reflect the actual cost of running the SNN clinics.

If this pilot program succeeds, we plan to expand the Lewis County Fund to increase the Spay/Neuter/Now Voucher Program discounts at participating veterinarians for Lewis County clients as well. Below are the current SNN voucher amounts:

Canine Female \$50	Feline Female \$40
Canine Male \$40	Feline Male \$25
